Tony Njuguna

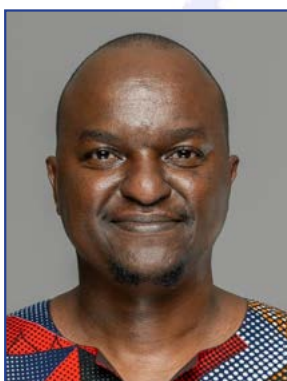
