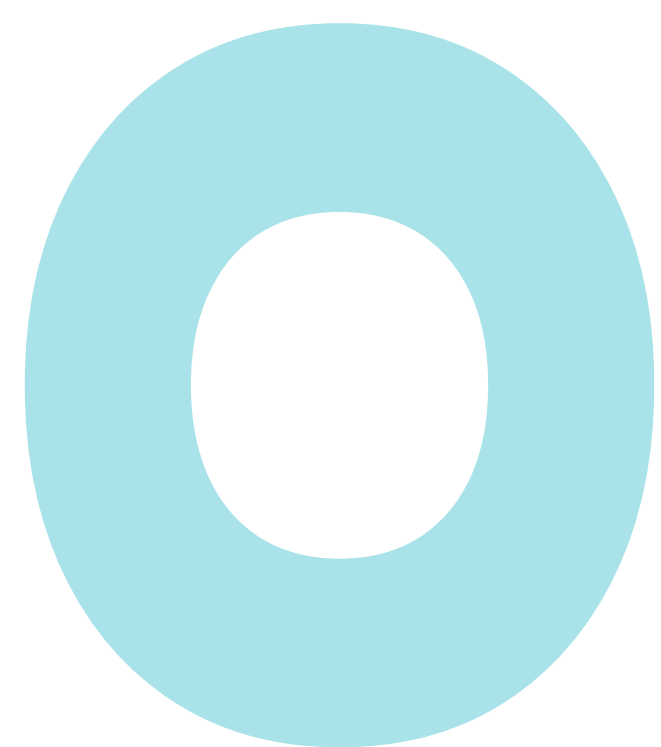
LESSON 6-CHAPTER 6:JESUS DID THE RIGHT THINGS FOR THE RIGHT REASONS

ADVICE FOR CLG/YLG FACILITATOR

This lesson outline enables the person leading the discussion in a Community Life Group (CLG facilitator) or Youth Life Group (YLG facilitator) to have a deeper understanding of the lesson content so that they can direct and guide the discussion effectively. Therefore, the CLG/YLG facilitator is advised to read and understand the lesson outline before leading the discussion session.

It is beneficial for the CLG/YLG Members go through a process of self-discovery as they share experiences, thoughts and scripture in response to the questions set forth in this lesson. As such, the CLG/YLG Facilitator is encouraged to share the questions and memory verse first, then they can choose to share the lesson outline at the conclusion of the session.

Key Theme: Motivation matters—love is the foundation of Christian action.





Lesson Outline:

- Motivation vs. manipulation—same action, different heart.
- Love as the pure motivation for serving, giving, correcting.
- Legalism appears to do the right things but not for the right reasons.
- Avoiding legalism—God values the heart more than the ritual.
- Jesus always put people first—not manmade rules and judgments.
- Responding to others' evil motives without becoming bitter.

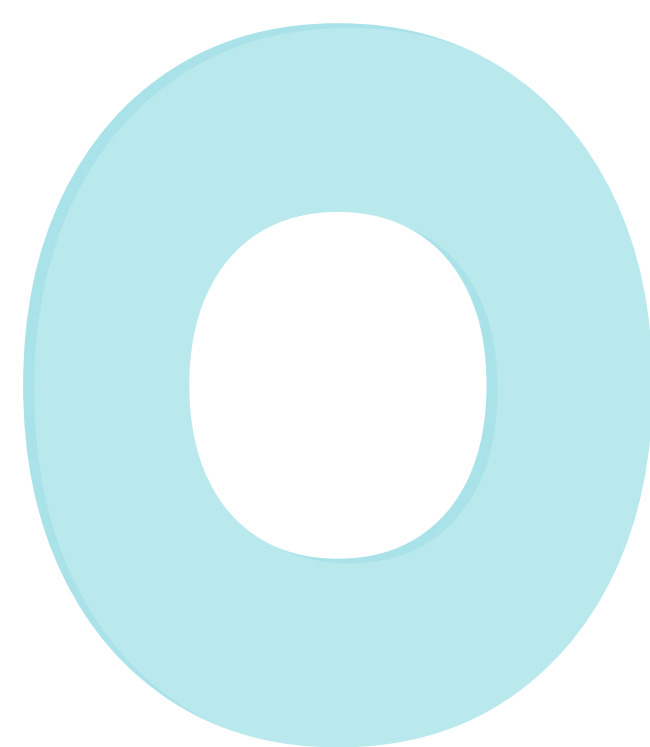

Discussion Questions:

Scripture reference: Mathew 6:1-4, Micah 6:8, Mark 3:1-6, Luke 15:25-32

1. Share three key lessons that you learnt from last Sunday's sermon and from the Readings of Chapter 6?
2. When have you felt challenged to do the right thing for the right reason in a tricky situation? How did you handle the criticism or judgment you received from others?
3. What are some rules and social expectations, either unspoken or explicit, that people tend to prioritize over relationships? Which one do you find especially troublesome?
4. Why do you suppose Jesus was so direct in his rebuke of the Pharisees and their regard for Sabbath laws? Why do you think their attitudes upset him so much?
5. How can you guard against legalism in the way you lead and serve others? What are some signs that you're likely slipping off the high road and losing sight of the right reasons for what you're doing?

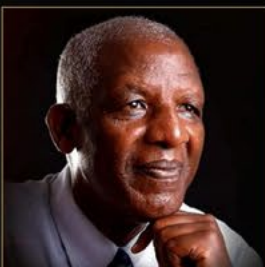

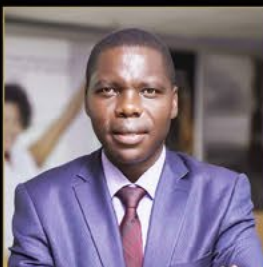
