- · Is NOT superficial peace or avoiding conflict.
- Is NOT merely social harmony

R. C. Sproul on his thoughts around this writes that - The pattern of unity in John 17 is not institutional uniformity but relational indwelling. The Son is in the Father; the Father in the Son; and we in them. This is the architecture of redeemed community.

John Stott put it this way: Our relationships should be a reflection of the relationships within the Godhead.

## ADVICE FOR CLG/YLG FACILITATOR

This lesson outline enables the person leading the discussion in a Community Life Group (CLG facilitator) or Youth Life Group (YLG facilitator) to have a deeper understanding of the lesson content so that they can direct and guide the discussion effectively. 


