## Comparing and counting score is deadly to relationships,

yet \_\_\_\_\_ is the central measure of God.

Keeping score is for \_\_\_\_\_, not \_\_\_\_\_!

- Keeping a true score requires more \_\_\_\_\_ than you can have.
- Be careful about \_\_\_\_\_: they can create injury when not realised. (Proverbs 13:12a.)

The value of a human being is in that each one bears the image of God, has been created by God and for God (not for you). (Romans 14:4a NIV)
