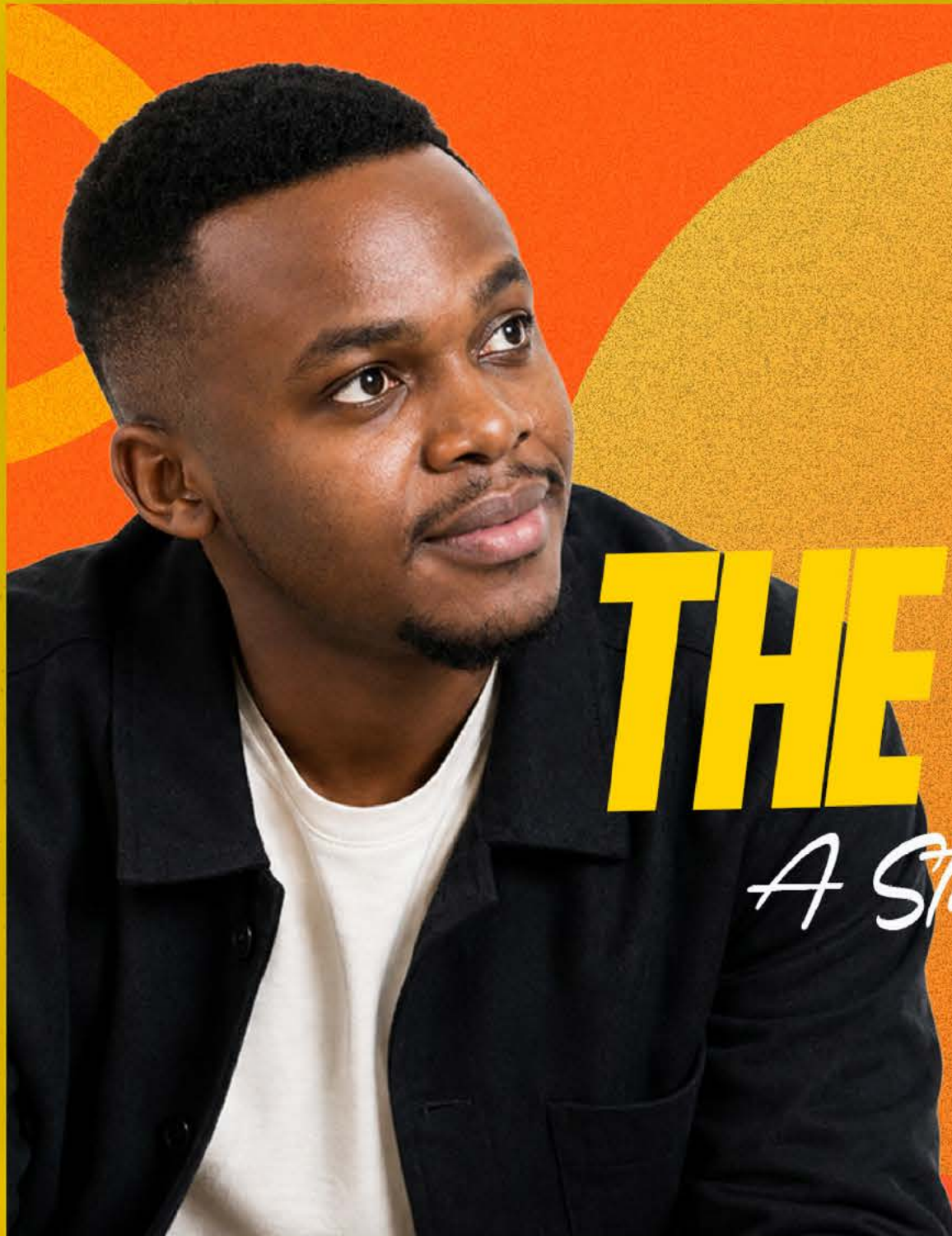

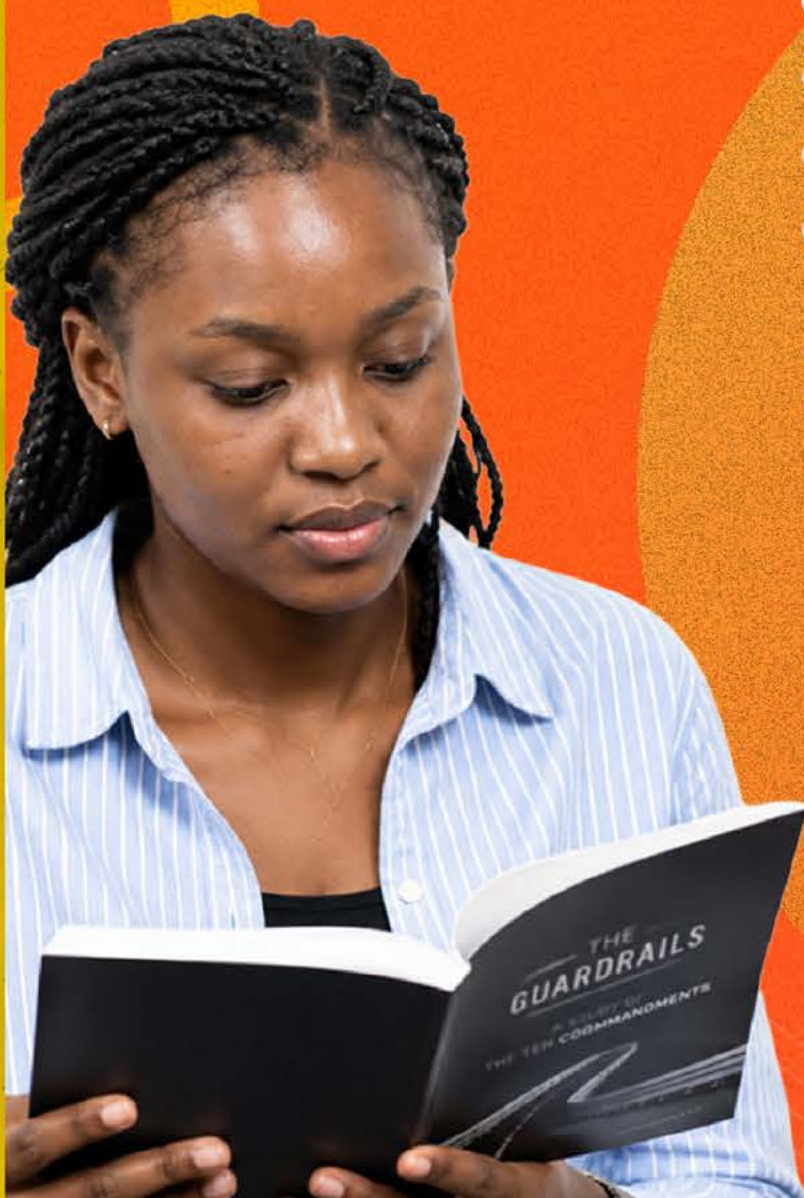

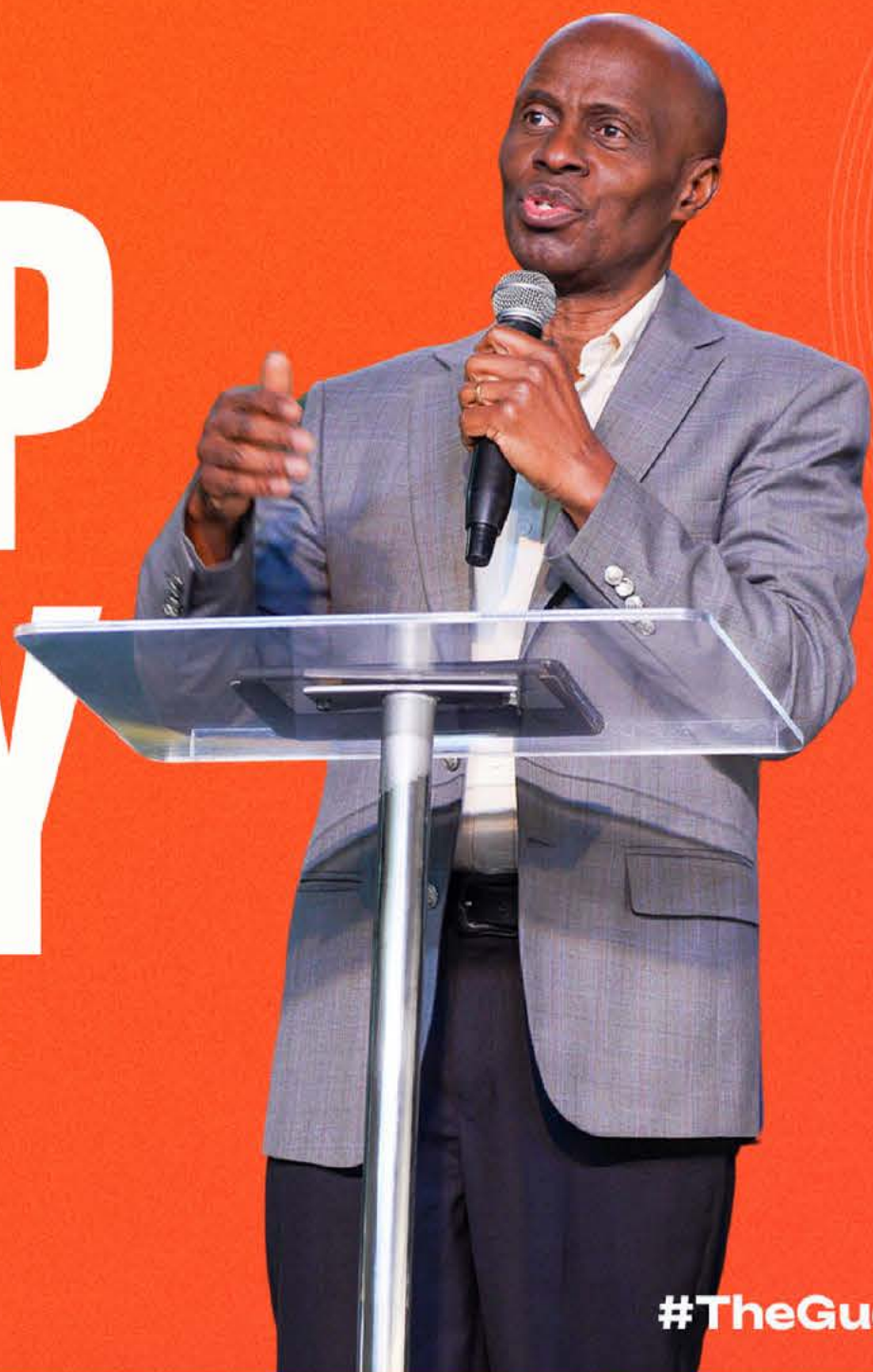

Sermon Notes

Exodus 20:1-3 And God spoke all these words: ² “I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. ³ “You shall have no other gods before me.

1. The preamble

Exodus 20:1 And God spoke all these words:

In the ancient Near East region, where the Israelites received the Law, Kings would demand the exclusive loyalty of their subject people. They would announce their sovereignty by introducing themselves by name, and then list their mighty deeds, after which they would issue decrees in that order. The introduction to the Moral Law (Exodus 20:1-3) follows the same order.

- a) The _____ behind the Moral Law is God himself (Ex. 20:1).
- b) He personally communicated the Moral law to the Israelites by _____ speaking to them collectively and individually (Ex. 19:16-19, 20:1).
- c) He used verbal words to convey the Moral Law to them and then _____ it on stone tablets with his own figure, after which they were securely _____ in the Ark of the Covenant (Ex. 20:1, 24:12, 25:16, 31:18).

2. The identity and nature of God

Exodus 20:2(a)

“I am the LORD your God...”

- a) God identifies himself as _____ (LORD), the personal name he revealed to Moses. “I am who I am.” It declares the uniqueness of God. He is the eternal, self-existent God (aseity). He is unlike anything in the created world due to his transcendent, holy (his otherness), perfect, and divine nature. Only he has the power of being, in and of himself. Everything else, including the universe, had a beginning and is contingent, is derived, and dependent on him to lend being to it. YHWH does not derive his being from something before or outside of him. (Gen 2:7, Exodus 3:13-14, Ex. 34:6-7, Num. 16:22, Deut. 30:20, Ps. 46:1, Acts 17: 28, Heb. 1:3). He is the source and ground of all being. continually sustaining creation by the power of his Word.

- b) God also identifies himself as _____ (God), often used when referring to God the creator (Gen. 1:1). The Hebrew noun means God, from the root word ‘*El*’ which means supreme greatness, majesty, strength, the strong one with total power. The suffix – ‘im’ at the end of the word makes it grammatically a standard masculine plural in Hebrew. Even though it is plural in form, when it appears in the Hebrew Bible, it usually pairs with singular verbs and adjectives. In these cases, it refers to a single, singular deity—specifically the God of Israel. (in reference to his triune nature of God - the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit)
- c) A God who is in a covenant relationship with his people and identifies with them as their God. ‘*The Lord ___ God*’ is covenant language referring to a people chosen by grace as a special and treasured possession (Ex. 19:5).

2. The mighty deeds of God in salvation.

Exodus 20:2(b) “...who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.”

- a) God _____ his people from exile in a foreign land, and they are now on their way to the promised land. He identified with his people when they were away from the promised land.
- b) His work in the redemption and _____ of his people from bondage and slavery revealed a loving, caring, and good God, who works for the welfare of his people.

3. The first commandment

Exodus 20:3 “You shall have no other gods before me.

- a) _____ to YHWH as the self-existent, life-giving God.

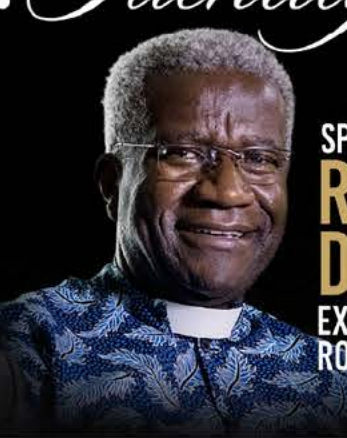

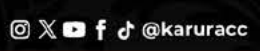

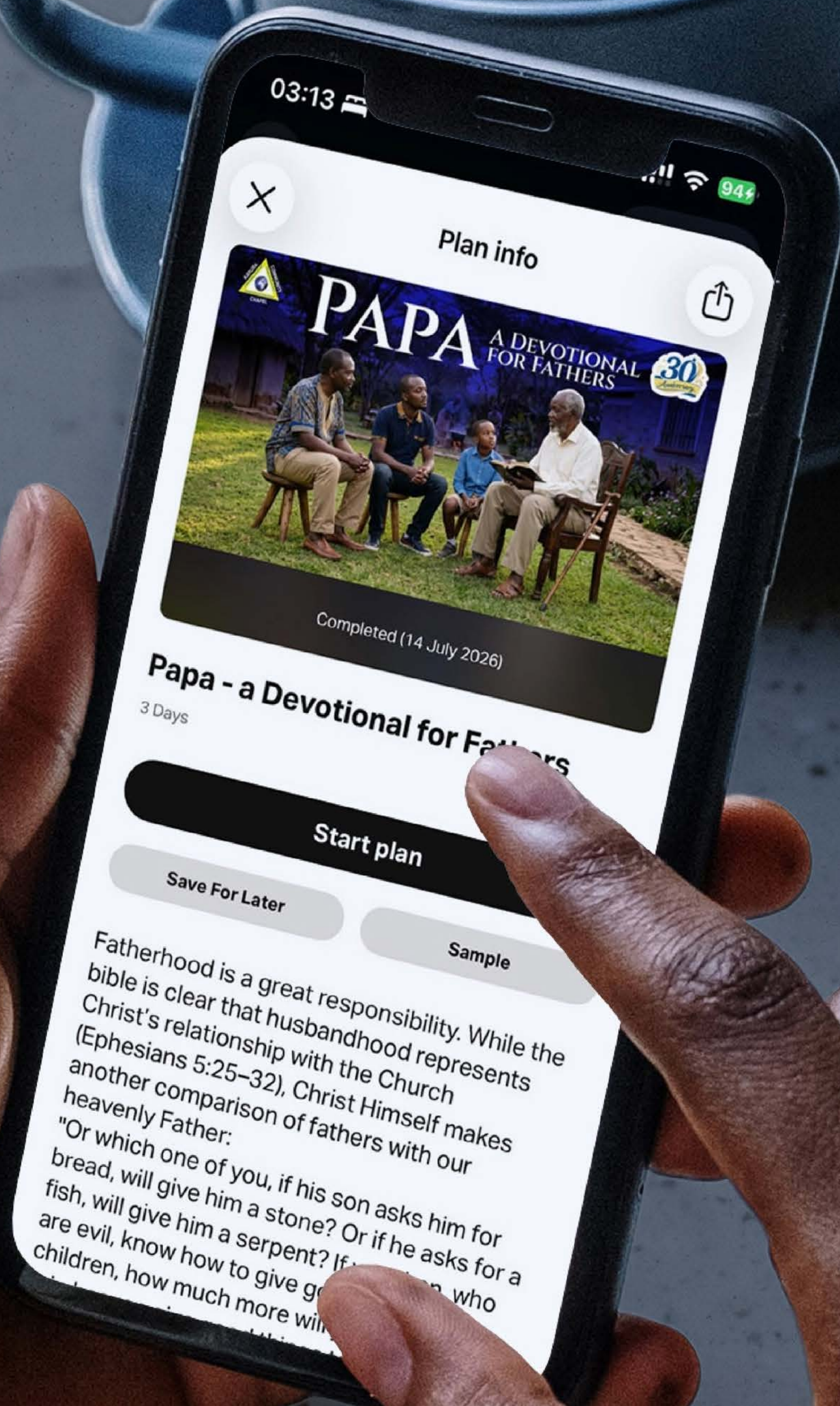
